GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Please fill out this application form COMPLETELY. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
2. Submissions can be sent electronically or by regular mail. Emailed submissions must be sent to the editor at bjieditor@gmail.com. As images sent with any submission must be high-resolution (print quality; 300 dpi minimum), it will be necessary to send images to the editor through a file-sharing platform such as Dropbox or a file-sharing platform of your choice. Mailed entries must include a CD, flash drive or other storage device containing high-resolution images depicting the center, or full-color prints of the center (please use a professional developing company; prints made on home printers are not considered to be "print quality").
3. Suggested but not mandatory: Include a one-page "project sheet," detailing the philosophy behind the facility's design.
4. The entry for this year is September 13, 2019. Winners will be featured in the November 2019 issue of Bowlers Journal International.9

Entries found to have been submitted incorrectly or inaccurately in any category will be disqualified without notice.

Submissions containing images that are not high-resolution (print quality: 300dpi minimum) will be disqualified without notice.
